

➤ **DOCS** New SSR code for Passport/Document Data to transmit to Airlines

The International Air Transport Association (IATA) is introducing a new SSR item to transmit Passport or Document details to airlines.

3DOCS(segment number)/(document type)/(document issue country)/(document number)/(document nationality country)/(date of birth)/(gender)/(document expiration date)/(last name)/(first name)-(name field)

**3DOCS/P/CY/89C87653/CY/24AUG1960/M/15MAR2011/ANDREOU/ANDREAS-2.1**

Segment Number is an **Optional** Field.

Segment number can be numerals from 1-99, or blank to indicate "all segments".

Document Type is a **Mandatory** Field

Acceptable documents types include:

- A - Alien resident card
- C - Permanent resident card
- P - Passport
- T - Refugee travel document and re-entry permit, US Travel document
- F - Facilitation document
- M - Military
- N - Naturalization certificate
- V - Border crossing card

Document Nationality Country is a **Mandatory** field.

Country codes must be valid 2 or 3 alpha character codes (CY, CYP, for example)

The document number cannot exceed 3 alphanumeric characters.

Date of Birth is a **Mandatory** Field

Use the format ddmmmyy or ddmmmyyyy.

Do not exceed 9 alphanumeric characters.

Gender is a **Mandatory** Field

Acceptable gender codes include:

- M - Male
- F - Female
- MI - Male traveling with an Infant
- FI - Female traveling with an Infant
- U - Unknown at the time of booking

Do not exceed 2 alpha characters.
