

Enhanced PNR Search and List

Sabre Travel Network® recently released a series of new capabilities that enable you to perform new types of searches to find your PNR, and provide a new content enriched name list display containing the search results.

New PNR search capabilities include:

- Similar Name Search – based on Similar Name List processing using Oracle industry standard Soundex
- Wild Card Name Search – based on names that **starts** with the characters listed in search input
- Exact Name Search – based on the exact name entered in search input

Each of these new searches can be further qualified using new **search parameters** – including destination or city pair.

Enriched name list display includes new information not currently available:

- PNR content data that reflects the most up-to-date information in the PNR
- Destination of first segment (air segments includes origin too)
- Segment type of the first segment (air segments include carrier code and flight number)
- Flight date and destination on the “next air segment”, when the passenger’s trip has commenced

| Redisplay the last displayed list | *L |

- Inclusion of a Cross of Lorraine (¥) in certain current search formats result in the return of the Enhanced Name List Display
- Qualifier “N” at the beginning of the input indicates to search on exact name. The qualifier may be used with any search format that includes a name
- Wildcard indicator is the ¥ (Cross of Lorraine), and can be used once in the input; either in the surname field or the first name field
