

## **Enhanced Rule Display**

We are proud to introduce the Enhanced Rule Display!

Enhanced Rule Display opens new access points to view fare rules immediately following your pricing formats. Improves your accuracy and efficiency in reviewing specific rules for your customers and review an area of interest, ticketing, travel, rule penalties – all critical for you to know and understand about the fare to advise your customers.

When you price a PNR you may see useful messages between the Endorsement text and the Validating Carrier information.

- You should check the fare rules.....But do you?

Well now you can in one easy step with Enhanced Rule Display.

The primary format following a pricing command is **WPRD\***

### **What problem does this solve in the marketplace today?**

Enhanced Rule Display is released with some best practice suggestions to address know challenges facing the industry.

#### **Best practice 1:**

Review the rules prior to ticketing, looking specifically for free text notes, that does not automate under pricing. The prime candidate is Category 15 – Sales Restrictions, where carriers add notes about plating carriers that must be used to qualify for the fare. Adhering to these instructions will assist in avoiding ADMs.

**Best practice 2:** Under command pricing Sabre provides warning messages to advise agents which rules have been overridden. Review the fare rules for these categories so you can rebook the itinerary to comply with the rules and avoid ADMs.

**Best practice 3:** Review all fare rules for the itinerary as some rule categories are most restrictive and apply to the entire pricing unit while others are only applicable to the fare component.

The WPRD\* command allows you to display fare rules following any of the following pricing commands:

- WP
- WPQ
- WPA
- WPNC
- WPNCB
- WPNCS
- WP\* (redisplay)
- WPNI\*

**Note:** Enhanced Rule Display is valid following a WPNI command, but only after you have selected an option from the shopping offerings and have actually priced the chosen itinerary.

<b>Format</b>	<b>Task</b>
WPRD*	Display a fare rule following any pricing format
WPRD**	Redisplay the last fare rule that you requested using an enhanced rule display
WPRD*P(passenger type)	Display a fare using a passenger type. You can only request the fare rules for one passenger type at any one time. When using the passenger type qualifier, always place it directly after the basic WPRD* Example: WPRD*PCNN
WPRD*S(segment number)	Display a fare rule using a specific segment or a range of segments. Examples: WPRD*S1, WPRD*S3-5, WPRD*S1/2/4
WPRD*Q(fare basis code)	Display a fare rule using a fare basis code Example: WPRD*QX2A3
WPRD*M	Display a fare rule requesting the rule menu
WPRD*C(category number)	Display a fare rule using the rule category number Example: WPRD*C16 to check the penalty rule

You can combine qualifiers, but you must separate them with a Cross of Lorraine symbol (‡).
