



## Secure Flight implementation

As from the 2nd of February, and in conjunction with our Secure Flight project, there is a global implementation which allows you to set the DOCS SSR field as a mandatory element in the PNR when the itinerary contains a US origin and/or destination.

This functionality is controlled by an optional TJR edit and the default is OFF. This edit will not be applied until your agency switches it on.

Once activated, End Transaction will validate the reservation to ensure each passenger has a DOCS item when the itinerary contains a US origin and/or destination requiring DOCS, DOCO or DOCA information.

When activated, End Transaction will:

- check the itinerary to validate if the itinerary contains a US origin and/or destination
- each passenger must have, at a minimum, a corresponding DOCS SSR otherwise the system will provide the following error: FLIGHTS REQUIRE DOCS FOR PASSENGER

In the event a DOCS is unavailable, you have the ability to override with a second End Transaction.

### Turning the Edit On/Off

In order to enable this edit, you must have the Employee Profile Record (EPR) keyword SUBMGR to update the Travel Journal Record (TJR).
