

## **Sunset of Stored Fare WS pricing entry**

As the WS programs cannot be expanded any further all future enhancements for storing and retrieving pricing details will be built upon PQ (Price Quote) functionality.

The WS functionality is scheduled to be sunset in year 2008. The Price Quote (PQ) functionality will become the only method of storing auto priced fares and ticketing instructions within a PNR.

After the WS entry is sunset, agencies/users will be able to still view or display fare information using the \*WS format.

If agencies/users try to use the WS entry after the sunset , SABRE will respond:

### **‡WS NOT ALLOWED - USE PQ-0132‡**

If you would like to turn on the PQ functionality just update your TJR with the following entry:

W/PQR‡ON

**Note:** Changes to the TJR require the keyword SUBMGR and duty code 9 in your Employee Profile Record (EPR).

The Price Quote (PQ) record is a new format that expands the amount of pricing information that can be stored and retrieved from the ticketing database.

- Store pricing data and ticketing instructions together in one PNR area
- Enable ticketing from multiple PQ records in one entry
- Utilize new displays to verify fare and ticketing information
- Ability to view automated free baggage allowance
- Reduce agent processing time and pricing errors

The expanded information fields offered within the PQ are used in association with many product offerings such as:

- Quick Refunds and Exchanges (QREX) tool
- Automated Free Baggage Allowance
