



Ticketing Authority Project

Sabre is working on a project to synchronize ticketing authorities in BSPLink with those in the TJRs, at the request of IATA and a mandate that as of the 1st May 2009, BSPLink is the only source for ticketing authority data. Over a period of time IATA have been using the data from tickets issued to inform both airlines and agents of mismatches between data present in BSPLink and tickets issued. Based on the occurrences of mismatches Sabre and all the GDSs will be running a synchronization program that will remove any ticketing authorities not present in BSPLink. IATA has chosen Austria and Cyprus as the first two markets and the synchronization will occur on 15 July 2009.

All IATA agents have been informed via BSPLink on the 8th of July 2009 for this project. Any ticketing authority that an agent finds missing should be reported to the airline directly.
